TOP 5 RULES FOR COMBINING FONTS

Use fonts within the same font family. These fonts were made for each other, use that to your advantage.

When selecting from different fonts, avoid paring fonts that are too similar. Contrast is key.

Narrow the number of fonts used to two or three. Too much contrast leads to inconsistency.

Highlight what matters most. Find what you want the viewer to read first, and make sure that is your dominant font.

> When in doubt, mix Serifs with a Sans Serifs. These two are natural pairs.
